To prepare for the interruption, please consider the following:

- Medical Equipment - ensure that your backup system is functioning
- Electric Garage Doors - place in manual mode or detach from the drive motor
- Sump Pump – electrical sump pumps will not function during power interruption
- Refrigerators / Freezers - minimize the opening of doors during the period of the interruption
- Security Systems - if you have a system monitored by an outside agency, be sure to notify them
- Elevators - should be locked down unless powered by backup generators
- Telephones, fax machines, computers and answering machines may be affected if not on an Uninterruptible Power Source (UPS)
- Hot Water – availability is dependent upon the size of your storage tank
- Digital Equipment – if no battery backup, equipment will need to be reset
- Cable TV or Internet – in some cases this service may not be operational during the power interruption and may remain so for an extended period after your power has been restored
