Designated Consumer Categories

Government

A municipality as defined in the *Municipal Act*, including a regional and district municipality and the County of Oxford.

Education

A university or college of applied arts and technology or other post-secondary education institution that receives regular and ongoing operating funds from Ontario for the purpose of providing post-secondary education. A board or private school, both as defined in the *Education Act*.

Hospital

A hospital as defined in the *Public Hospitals Act*, a private hospital operated under the authority of a licence issued under the *Private Hospitals Act*, an institution as defined in the *Mental Hospitals Act*, a hospital within the meaning of the *Community Psychiatric Hospitals Act*, a psychiatric facility within the meaning of the *Mental Health Act*, a cancer centre established by Cancer Care Ontario under the *Cancer Act*.

Retirement and Rest Homes

A nursing home within the meaning of the *Nursing Homes Act* or a home within the meaning of the *Homes for the Aged and Rest Homes Act*, a commercially operated residence for seniors or retired persons, or any other similar commercially operated residence, where attainment of a mature age is a factor in being accepted for occupancy.

Registered Charity

A registered charity as defined in subsection 248(1) of the *Income Tax Act* (Canada) that has a registration number issued by the Canada Customs and Revenue Agency. An approved charitable institution within the meaning of the *Charitable Institutions Act*.

Residential Complex

A consumer who has an account which relates to a dwelling, a property as defined in the *Condominium Act, 1998*, a residential complex as defined in the *Tenant Protection Act, 1997* or a property that includes one or more dwellings and that is owned or leased by a co-operative as defined in the *Co-operative Corporations Act*.

Health and Long Term-Care

A nursing station, health centre, clinic or other facility that receives funding through the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care's Underserved Area Program. A facility owned or leased by a person who receives funding for one or more of the following health care support services that are provided to or are available to residents of the facility: a residential treatment services program, a withdrawal management services program, or a dedicated supportive housing project. A home for special care within the meaning of the *Homes for Special Care Act*. A community care access corporation within the meaning of the *Community Care Access Corporations Act, 2001*. Cancer Care Ontario. A service provider within the meaning of the *Long-Term Care Act, 1994*. A board of health within the meaning of the *Health Protection and Promotion Act*. A community health centre or a comprehensive health organization within the meaning of Ontario Regulation 396/93 under the *Pay Equity Act*. A district health council established under the *Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care Act*. A facility owned by Canadian Blood Services. An independent health facility operated under the authority of a licence issued under the *Independent Health Facilities Act*. An organization that receives funding under the *Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care Act*. A place where an aboriginal healing and wellness program that receives funding under the Aboriginal Healing and Wellness Strategy is provided.

Child Support & Services

A place where a resource centre program, a recreational program or a day nursery receiving funding under the *Day Nurseries Act* are provided. A residence licensed as a children's residence under the *Child and Family Services Act*. A facility where child development services, child treatment services, child welfare services, community support services, young offenders services, or child and family intervention services, within the meaning of the *Child and Family Services Act*, are provided. An Ontario Early Years Centre or a satellite program of an Ontario Early Years Centre that receives funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act*.

Adult Support & Services

A facility designated by the regulations under the *Developmental Services Act* as a facility to which that Act applies, other than a facility listed in Schedule 1 to Regulation 272 of the Revised Regulations of Ontario, 1990 made under that Act. A sheltered workshop, a place where a supported employment program, an adults' community support service, an employment preparation, training and job placement program, a violence against women program, a discharge planning for ex-offenders program, interpreter services of intervenor services programs, or Rehabilitation Services for the Disabled are provided, that receive funding under the *Developmental Services Act* or the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act*. A place where an employment supports program that receives funding under the *Ontario Disability Support Program Act, 1997* is provided. A district social services administration board established under the *District Social Services Administration Boards Act*.

Housing

A place where emergency hostel services are provided under the *Ontario Works Act, 1997*. A domiciliary hostel or a place where an emergency shelter service or homelessness prevention program are provided that receive funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act*.
